REFUND POLICY

To receive credit after payment has been made, students, sponsors must notify the World Affairs Seminar in writing that their delegate is unable to attend, or if the sponsor is unable to fill a paid for space at the Seminar. (e-mail is considered "in writing" for these purposes as long as the e-mail is acknowledged as having been received.) Full credit applies if notification is received by April 1; 50% credit if application is cancelled between April 1 but prior to May 21; no credit is available if application is cancelled after May 21, unless extraordinary circumstances such as illness, or death. All cancellation credits are subject to \$75.00 processing fee and must be used within one calendar year. **Note:** in agreeing to attend WAS, parents and students promise to reimburse their sponsor for the full amount of any loss due to cancellation.
